Position Summary

The Visualization Technologist is a visual storyteller who will play a key role in creating compelling imagery that demonstrates urban design ideas and solutions as interpreted from design sketches and drawings. The position requires working closely and collaboratively alongside the Community and Urban Design team.

Responsibilities

- Creating captivating visualizations, 3D models, renderings, diagrams and visual layouts that convey a design vision;
- Estimating time to complete tasks and delivering sophisticated images on deadline; and
- Discovering and mastering new tools and visualization techniques.

Skills and Competencies

The core skill of the Visualization Technologist is the ability to tell stories and communicate ideas visually. This position requires a self-motivated individual with excellent design and organizational skills and the ability to manage time effectively, often working on multiple projects with tight deadlines. The ability to thrive in high-pressure situations with a proactive and flexible mindset is key. An understanding of technical standards in architecture and/or urban design is an asset.

Qualifications

- A degree or diploma in Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Urban Design, Illustration, Graphic Design or related fields;
- 2-3 years of work experience in an office environment in a similar or related role;
- Proficiency using AutoCad, Sketchup, V-Ray, Enscape, Adobe Suite (InDesign, Illustrator and Photoshop specifically) and Revit is mandatory;
- A developed portfolio demonstrating technical abilities, design sensibilities and artistic style;
- Experience in team, client and/or production management is an asset; and
- A keen eye for design and passion for storytelling through visual communication.
